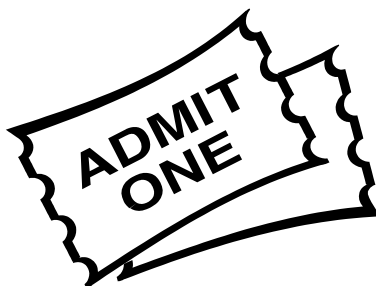


“Quilters” Play in Syracuse



What: Play based on book written by Molly Newman and Barbara Damashek

When: Sunday April 1, 2012 Play starts at 2pm Bus will leave Sew Nice parking lot at 12 noon
