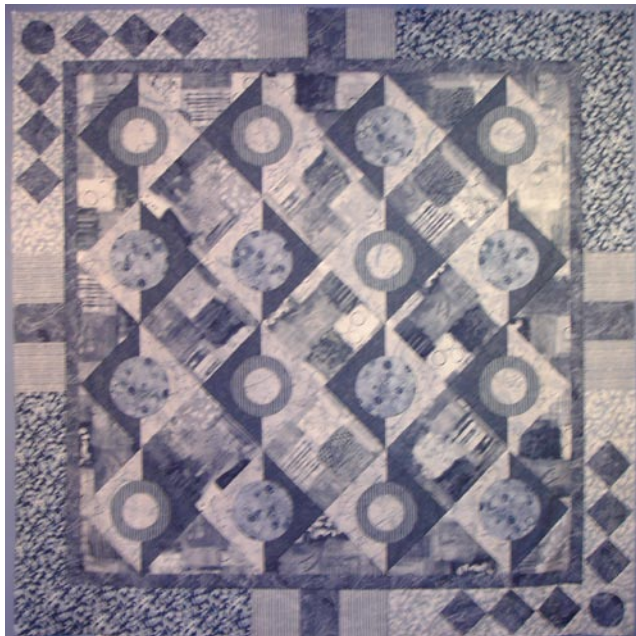

This throw quilt will be made in 3 classes. The circles in this quilt are appliqued not pieced. The first class will deal with how to cut fabric that is bigger pieces than your ruler and how to prepare your pieces for applique. The second class will be doing the applique and learning how to piece a quilt with blocks that are on-point. The third class will be how to make borders fit your quilt while still making sure that everything stays square. The fabrics used in the store sample is a wonderful line of cotton that looks like denim. We have 5 kits available using these fabrics however other fabrics will work to make this pattern.
